Dishwasher Leaks

Your dishwasher could leak for a variety of reasons. In some cases, there might be a malfunction with one of the dishwasher's parts; however, the common culprit is the detergent that was placed in the dishwasher itself. If too much dishwasher detergent was used, or if the wrong type of detergent was used (such as typical liquid detergent from the kitchen sink), then the dishwasher is going to overflow. Sadly, when a dishwasher leaks, it usually looks like a flood. If the dish detergent is the culprit, then every ounce of detergent has to be removed before the dishwasher is used again.

Refrigerator Leaks

If you recently purchased a new refrigerator, then you should know that this is going to produce a lot of moisture. Particularly during the summer, the refrigerator is going to

have to work extra hard to keep your food and drinks preserved. As a result, leaks could develop.

When the door is opened, warm air passes over the condenser coil. As a result, moisture accumulates and you might notice the fridge leaking water from bottom or the fridge freezer leaking water underneath. When the warm air makes contact with the condenser coil, condensation takes place and this moisture will leak. If you notice the fridge leaking water on floor or the fridge leaking water outside, the condenser coil is usually the culprit.

Washing Machine Leaks

Washing machine leaks can be dramatic, causing severe damage to the home due to the sheer volume of water they use. Some of the most common reasons why a washing machine might leak include:

- Issues with the hose connection
- Problems with the gasket
- A malfunction in the water pump
- Problems with the seal

Washing machine leaks must be addressed by trained professionals.

Water Heater Leaks

If the water heater is leaking, this can lead to major problems. The most common reason why a water heater leaks is a loose drain valve. This is located at the bottom of the tank and is used to remove sediment from the water heater. In some cases, the valve just has to be tightened; however, in some situations, it might have to be replaced entirely.
