Pro Tip: Don't just paint over it. The moisture needs to be fully addressed first, or mold and hidden rot may come back worse.

Repair or Replace: How to Decide



Not all ceiling damage is created equal. Use this quick guide:

Repair If:

1. Stains are surface-level

- 2. No structural damage or mold
- 3. You caught the leak early

Replace If:

- 1. Ceiling sags, bulges, or smells musty
- 2. Black spots or fuzzy mold appear
- 3. The drywall is soft or crumbly to the touch

Remember: <u>Water-damaged drywall</u> becomes a breeding ground for mold in under 48 hours if not properly dried.

When to Call a Professional
