- **Insulate the Pipes:** Some of the most common locations and what pipes freeze include the attic, the crawl space, and the exterior wall. Think about insulating them with snap-on foam or approved heat tape. Check out the instructions for manufacturers to make sure this is done properly.

• **Drip the Faucets:** While it can be annoying to deal with a dripping faucet, dripping the faucets while nobody is home and keep the water moving, making it hard for water to freeze in the pipes. This simple step can prevent stagnant water from freezing, leading to a busted pipe.
