Causes of a Swamp Cooler Leak

Some of the most common reasons why a swamp cooler might start to leak include:

- The swamp cooler's plumbing connections could develop corrosion or become loose
- The pads of the swamp cooler could have been dislodged or have to be replaced
- There is residue from the evaporation of hard water that is adversely impacting its ability to function

- The reservoir of the cooler has been cracked, allowing water to enter the home
- The float valve that is responsible for maintaining the water level of the swamp cooler has been altered, allowing water from the reservoir to overflow

If a swamp cooler leak is present, this could lead to serious damage throughout the building.

Signs of Water Damage

If there is a swamp cooler leak present, water damage could start to occur in the home. Some of the most common signs that water damage is present include:

- There are dark or wet spots that start to develop on the ceiling
- The drywall of the home is starting to crack or flake
- There is an odd smell coming from the plumbing system
- Wet spots and puddles start to form throughout the home
